DEPARTMENT OF THE INTERIOR BUREAU OF RECLAMATION CENTRAL UMAN PROJECT, INCAH

CONTRACT BETWEEN THE UNITED STATES AND THE ABILEY UPPER DELICATION COMPANY RELATING TO KNEHANDE AND ADJUSTMENT OF WATER RIGHTS

THIS COMMRACT, made this 12 day of September 1958, in pursuance of the Act of June 17, 1902 (32 Stat. 368) and acts amendatory thereof or supplementary thereto, particularly the Act of April 11, 1956 (70 Stat. 105), between THE UNITED SHATES OF AMERICA, herein styled the United States, acting in this behalf by the Regional Mrseter, Region 4. Bureau of Reclamation, Department of the Interior, hereinafter referred to as the Regional Director, and the ASHLEY DEPER ERRIGATION COMPANY, a corporation organised under the laws of the State of Utah with its place of business at Vernal, Wah, herein styled the Company:

WITHDOWN, That:

- 2. WHEREAS, the United States is planning the construction of the Varnal unit as part of the Central Utah Project, which unit is hereinafter referred to as the project, including facilities which will be used, smong other purposes, to deliver water into the Company canal, commonly known as the Askley Upper Canal, permitting an exchange of Commany water as hereignfter described for project water delivered from the proposed Stansker Beservoir.
- 3. WHEREAS, the Company has certain water rights in the flow of Ashley Creek as referred to in that certain decree entered by Judge Warren H. Dusenberry on Hovember 17, 1897, Unital County Case No. 18, and

- 4. Missisks, in order that there will be adequate unter supply for the project, it is necessary to establish the mount of unter that the Company will receive under the above-mentioned decree than said project is constructed and in operation.
- 5. NOW, THERMOORE, in consideration of the matual and dependent stipulations havein contained, it is agreed by and between the parties haveto as follows:
- 6. Pursuant to and by virtue of continued diversions under and in secondars with the above-mentioned decree, the Company claims 39.3 percent of the flow of Ashley Creek at USGS Gaging Station "Sign of the Heine" corrected for diversions to Stancker Mitch and the Vernal City pipaline for its water users and the Company agrees with respect to its water right as follows:
- e. The irrigation seeson is from April 1 to October 31 of each year. The irrigated lead served by the Company count is 9.630 serves, and the emmal irrigation demand for such land as it applies to decreed water, is 4.0 sero-fact per sero for April and May and 3.7 sero-fact for the remaining menths of the irrigation season, seemand at the Company's headquie diversion point. During the menintrigation season the Company's headquie diversion point. During the menintrigation season the Company's use for describe and stock watering purposes is 57 sero-fact.

b. Under graject operation and within the limits of its decreed wight in Ashley Creek, the Conyany must call for its water accombing to the fallowing achebiles

- (1) during April, not to exceed 4.8 payment of its emmal irrigation demend,
- (2) during May, not to exceed 17.0 percent of its command irrigution demand,
- (3) during Jume, not to exceed 20.2 percent of the ensual irrigation demand,
- (4) during July through October, not to exceed its decreed water rights in Ashley Creek,
- (5) during the accirrigation season (Sovember through March), not to exceed 0.391 c.f.s. of the flow of Ashley Creek.
- boom established on the assumption that the Chited States will construct as part of the project, a contrigation season water-cavings pipe system, or as otherwise may be egreed upon, so that the steeldedders A. System of the Company can run commentions therefrom to their property to foul. Confinence Company water during the manifelysation season.
- d. The smount of water that the Company will eall for as provided above is bereinsfeer called Company water and the Company berein quitolains to the Chited States its right to secrets of water in excess thereof and agrees that such assess water will become part of the project water supply, and further agrees to execute any appropriate conveyence or assignment to the United States of the water rights representing such excess water.
- 7. The Company hereby grants the United States the wight and the United States agrees without expanse to the Company, to company facilities as part of the project to deliver Company vater through the unter-cavings pipe system. The Company agrees

to sequire and denote to the United States by appropriate deed of conveyance, all right-of-way needed for the water-savings pipe system. The
United States agrees that during construction of the above-mentioned facilities there shall be a minimum of interference with the delivery of Company
water.

- 6. The United States agrees in the operation of the project to deliver Company non-irrigation season water through the water-savings pipe line constructed by the United States as provided in Article 6(c).
- 9. The United States shall install a measuring device to regulate and measure the flow of water into the said Company canal and into the water-savings pipe system.
- 10. It is understood and agreed by the parties hereto that certain actions will have to be taken as follows:
- a. The Company shall make application to the State Engineer of Utah for a change in the point of diversion of its Ashley Creek water as may be necessitated by the construction of the facilities by the United States. The United States will furnish the engineering information and detail necessary for the application.
- b. The United States will make application to the State Engineer of Utah for exchange of project water for Company water.
- e. The Company will accept delivery of project water in exchange for Company water that may be diverted and used on project lands above the Stansker Service Canal at such times as such project water of equal quality and quantity can be delivered at the name location as its Company water.

- d. Upon completion of the construction of the facilities to serve the Company and after the action described in subarticles a. and b. above have been taken, the United States and the Company will advise the Water Commissioner of all actions taken and furnish him operating criteria to be followed in satisfying the Company's rights, and the exchange to be made pursuant to this contract.
- Il. The Company canal may need some rehabilitation and lining. The extent of such rehabilitation and lining shall be determined by the United States after consultation with the board of directors of the Company and shall be performed without expense to the Company. Should it be necessary to convey the title of the Company's canal to the United States in order to undertake the rehabilitation and lining, the Company agrees to make such conveyance, provided, however, that the Company shall operate and maintain such canal at its own expense after such rehabilitation work has been performed.
- 12. The liability of the United States under this contract is contingent on the necessary appropriation and reservation of funds being made therefor.
- 13. It is understood that the covenants and agreements herein are made in anticipation of, and are conditional upon, the completion of the construction of the project.
- 14. The Company warrants that no person or selling agency has been employed or retained to solicit or secure this contract upon an agreement or understanding for a commission, percentage, brokerage, or contingent fee, excepting bona fide employees or bona fide established commercial or selling agencies maintained by the Company for

the purpose of securing business. For breach or wielation of this warrenty the United States shall have the right to annul this contract without liability or in its discretion to require the Company to pay, in
addition to the contract price or consideration, the full amount of
such commission, percentage, or contingent fee.

- tract, the Company agrees not to discriminate against any employee or applicant for employment because of race, religion, color or national origin. The aforesaid provision shall include, but not be limited to, the following: employment, upgrading, demotion, or transfer; recruitment or recruitment advertising; layoff or termination; rates of pay or other forms of compensation; and selection for training, including apprenticeship. The Company agrees to post hereafter in conspicuous places, available for employees and applicants for employment, notices to be provided by the United States setting forth; the provisions of the non-discrimination clause. The Company further agrees to insert the foresping provision in all subcontracts hereunder, except subcontracts for standard commercial supplies or raw materials.
  - 16. No member of or Delegate to Congress or Resident Commissioner shall be admitted to any share or part of this contract or to any benefit that may arise herefrom, but this restriction shall not be construed to extend to this contract if made with a corporation or company for its general benefit.
  - 17. The provisions of this contract shall apply to and bind the successors and assigns of the parties hereto, but no assignment or

transfer of this contract, or any part thereof, or interest therein shall be valid until approved by the United States.
